

2025 Eligibility Info

3rd Grade

must be in the 3rd grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 10 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

or a player in the 4th grade that is 9 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

4th Grade

must be in the 4th grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 11 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

or a player in the 5th grade that is 10 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

5th Grade

must be in the 5th grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 12 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

or a player in the 6th grade that is 11 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

6th Grade

must be in the 6th grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 13 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

or a player in the 7th grade that is 12 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

7th Grade

must be in the 7th grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 14 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

or a boy in the 8th grade that is 13 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

8th Grade

must be in the 8th grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 15 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

or a boy in the 9th grade that is 14 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

9th Grade

must be in the 9th grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 16 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

or a boy in the 10th grade that is 15 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

10th Grade

must be in the 10th grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 17 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

or a boy in the 11th grade that is 16 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

11th/12th Grade

must be in the 11th or 12th grade as of October 1, 2024 (this past school year) & must be 19 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

ROSTER RULES

- players may play up in older divisions, but can not play down. They must fit the age and/or grade requirements to play in a division or be younger and playing up. For example, a 10th grader can play up in the 11th/12th grade division, but that same 10th grader can not play down in the 9th grade division (unless they meet the age requirements to play down in that division).

- a player may participate in a maximum of two separate age/grade divisions. They must meet the age/grade eligibility for both divisions they are playing in. Each player must be on the roster for both teams and the player must play within the same organization for both teams.

- players can NOT play on two teams within the same age/grade division. If you have two teams in the same grade level, you must have two totally separate rosters (as players can not play on two teams within the same age group).

-Post Grad (Prep School) players are not allowed to play.

Note: Home schooled players go by AGE ONLY and it doesn't matter what grade level courses they are taking. The following are the requirements for any home school players:

Home school player eligibility

3rd Grade: must be 9 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

4th Grade: must be 10 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

5th Grade: must be 11 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

6th Grade: must be 12 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

7th Grade: must be 13 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

8th Grade: must be 14 years old or younger on June 30, 2025

9th Grade: must be 15 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

10th Grade: must be 16 years old or younger on August 31, 2025

11/12th Grade: must be 18 years old or younger on August 31, 2025
